

# Make the Most of Your Smart Phone

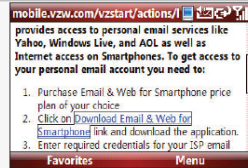
## Stay Connected All The Time

Did you know that you can sync your email account with your phone in order to receive and send emails from your phone?



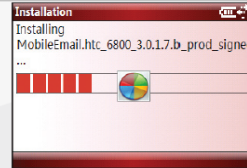
- 1 Select **Start, Internet Explorer, Email** and then **Email and Web for Smartphone**.

If the Internet Explorer page does not display the Email and Web for Smartphone option, select **Menu, Home** and then **Email and Web for Smartphone**.



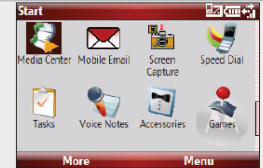
- 2 Select the link for your device.

**NOTE:** Motorola Q users, after launching Internet Explorer:  
 - Select **Menu, Address Bar**  
 - Enter <http://mobile.vzwapp.com>  
 - Select **Go, Email** and then **Email and Web for Smartphone**.

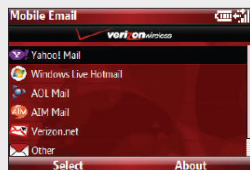


- 3 If presented with **Open file after download** option, select it and then select **Yes**.

Otherwise, just select **Yes**.  
 The file will auto install after it downloads. When prompted, select **Yes** to restart your device.

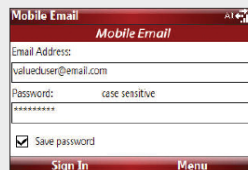


- 4 To launch Mobile Email on:  
 - Windows Mobile Professional Smartphone: Select **Start, Programs** and **Mobile Email**.  
 - Windows Mobile Standard Smartphone: Select **Start** and **Mobile Email**.



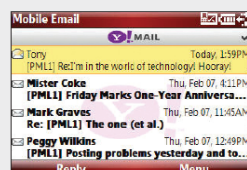
- 5 Select your **Email Provider**.

**NOTE:** If you selected **Other**, you may be prompted to enter additional information. Enter the information and then select **Sign In**. Tip: Often the user name is only the first part of the email address.



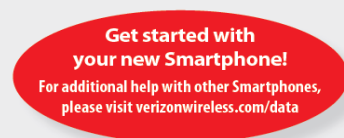
- 6 Enter your **Email Address** and **Password**.

If desired, select **Save Password** and then select **Sign In**.  
 To confirm a successful set up, send a test email to [email@vzw.com](mailto:email@vzw.com).  
 - The 10-digit number of your device must be included in the email subject line.  
 - You will receive a confirmation email.



- 7 Your Inbox will appear.

**NOTE:** The next time you launch Mobile Email, you will be able to select the account you just set up or select **Add Account** to configure additional accounts. Screen shots depicted are from the Motorola Q9m; on other devices screen shots may vary.



You must have the Email and Web for Smartphone feature added to your Verizon Wireless account to use the application.

## Personalize Your Phone



Did you know you can personalize your phone by customizing the notifications that alert you to new text messages, emails, upcoming calendar events, and incoming calls? Simply select **Start, Settings, and Sound and Notifications**. From there you can choose from a variety of sounds in order to personalize your phone.

See your favorite pictures every time you use the phone by customizing the background of your Today screen. Simply select **Start, Settings, and Today**. Then check off **Use this Picture** and browse your photo gallery and select your favorite picture.



## Talk Without Talking

In a class and want to find out where to meet your friends for lunch? In a meeting and need to relay a message to your spouse? Just text message it!

Create a new text message by selecting **Start, Programs, and Messaging**. Once in Messaging, tap **Select, Menu, and New**. Then select **SMS** and enter either the contact's name or phone number and begin typing your message.

## Keep Your Life Organized

Need an easy way to keep track of upcoming events? Use the calendar feature on your phone to schedule appointments, remind you of due dates, and much more!

Select the Calendar icon on the Today screen, then select **Menu** and **New Appointment**. Enter a name for the appointment, and enter information such as the start and end times. In order to receive an alert when your event is approaching, select the **Remind Me** box.



## Create Shortcuts

Need quick access to the weather or score of the game at your Penn State tailgate?

Create a shortcut which will allow you to access your favorite features of the phone in the Start Menu. Simply select **Start, Settings, and Menu**. Then select the features of the phone that you would like to appear in the start menu. These programs can include Internet Explorer, Camera, Games, and much more. This creates an easy way to access the programs without having to search through the phone for them.
